*Rhyme*

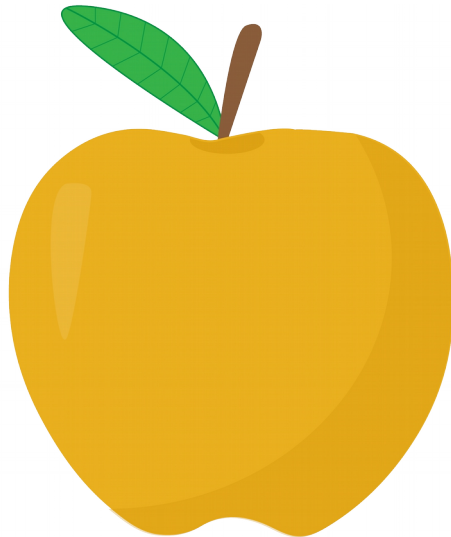
Five stuffed scarecrows in the corn rows (stand straight and tall)

Have you ever seen an apple, that grows on a tree?

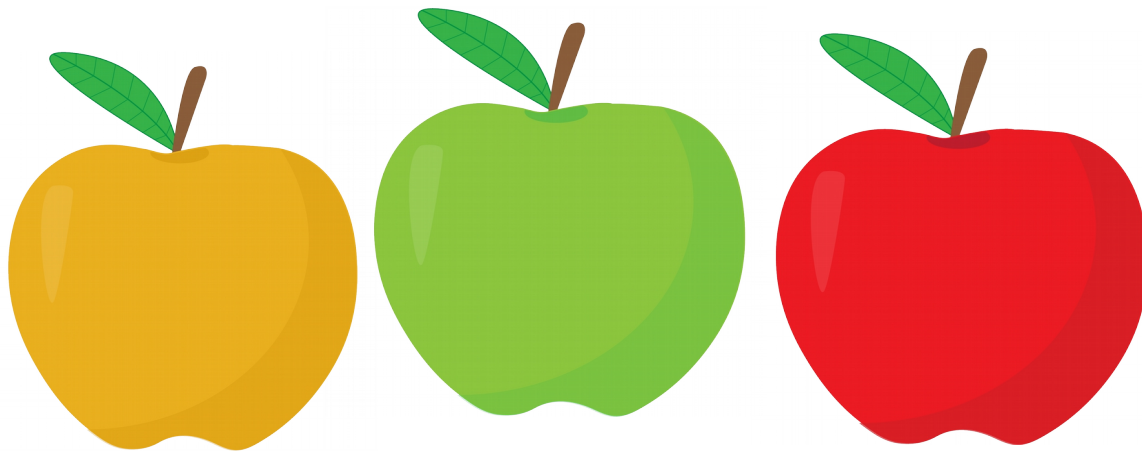


# Apple “Bingo” Song

# Autumn

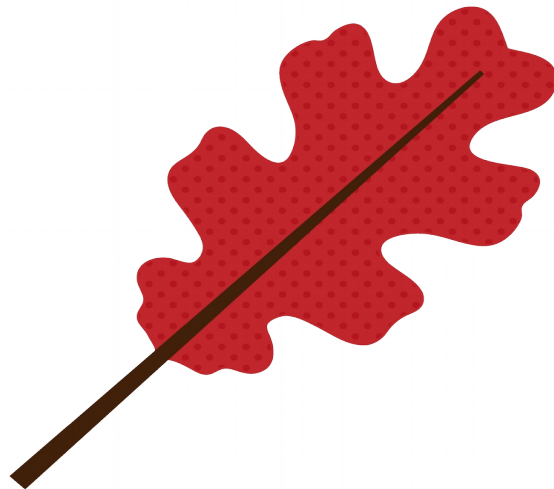
*Rhyme*

Twirling, whirling, all around, (turn self around)

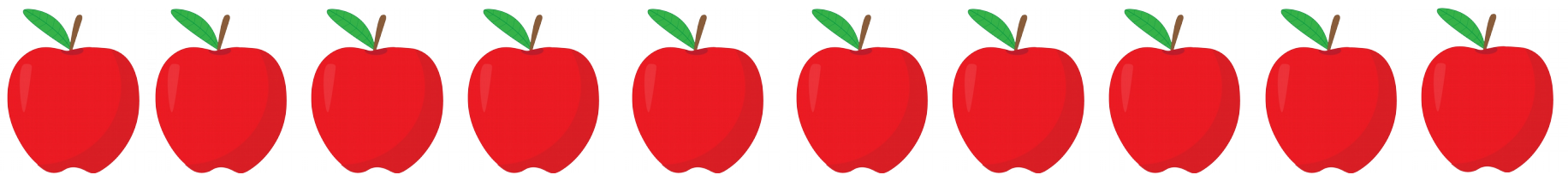
Till at last, they touch the ground. (fall to the ground)

*Rhyme*

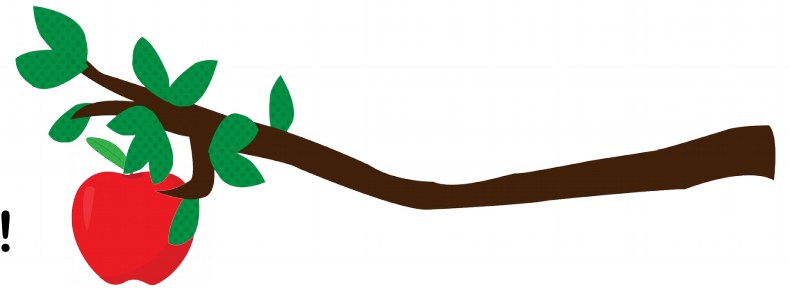
Just out of reach, so high in the tree,

*Rhyme*

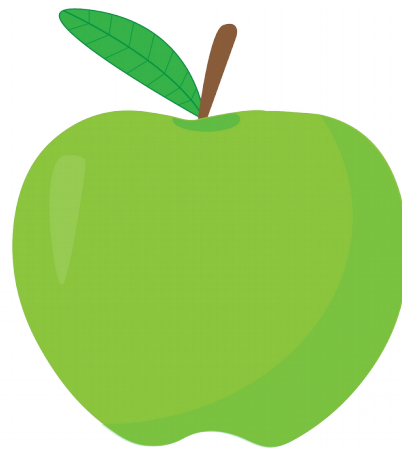
Scarecrow, scarecrow, turn around,
