the apple crop.**



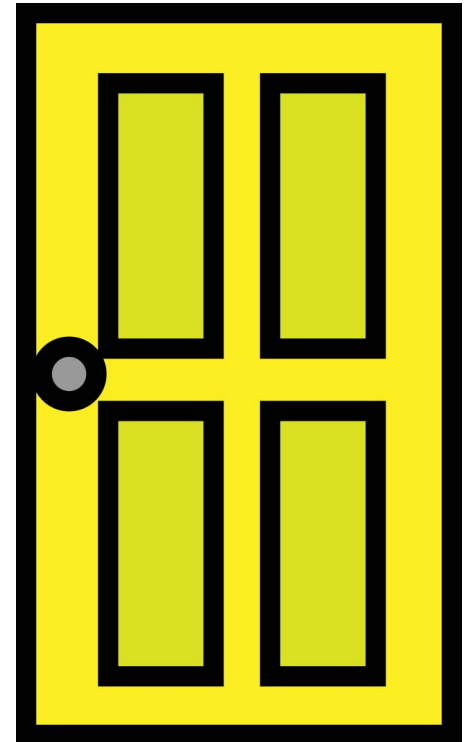


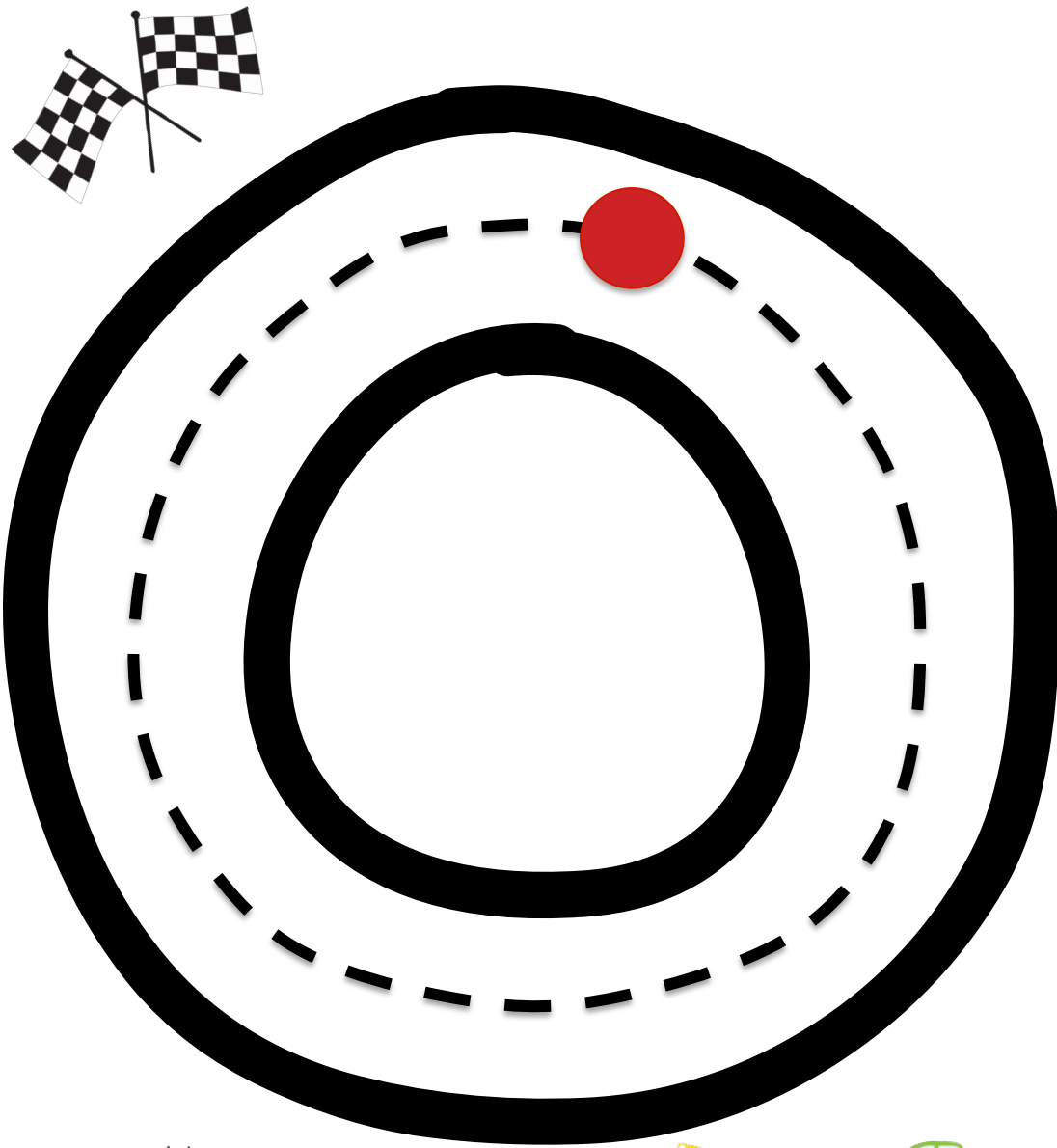
**Pull straight

1, 2, 3!**





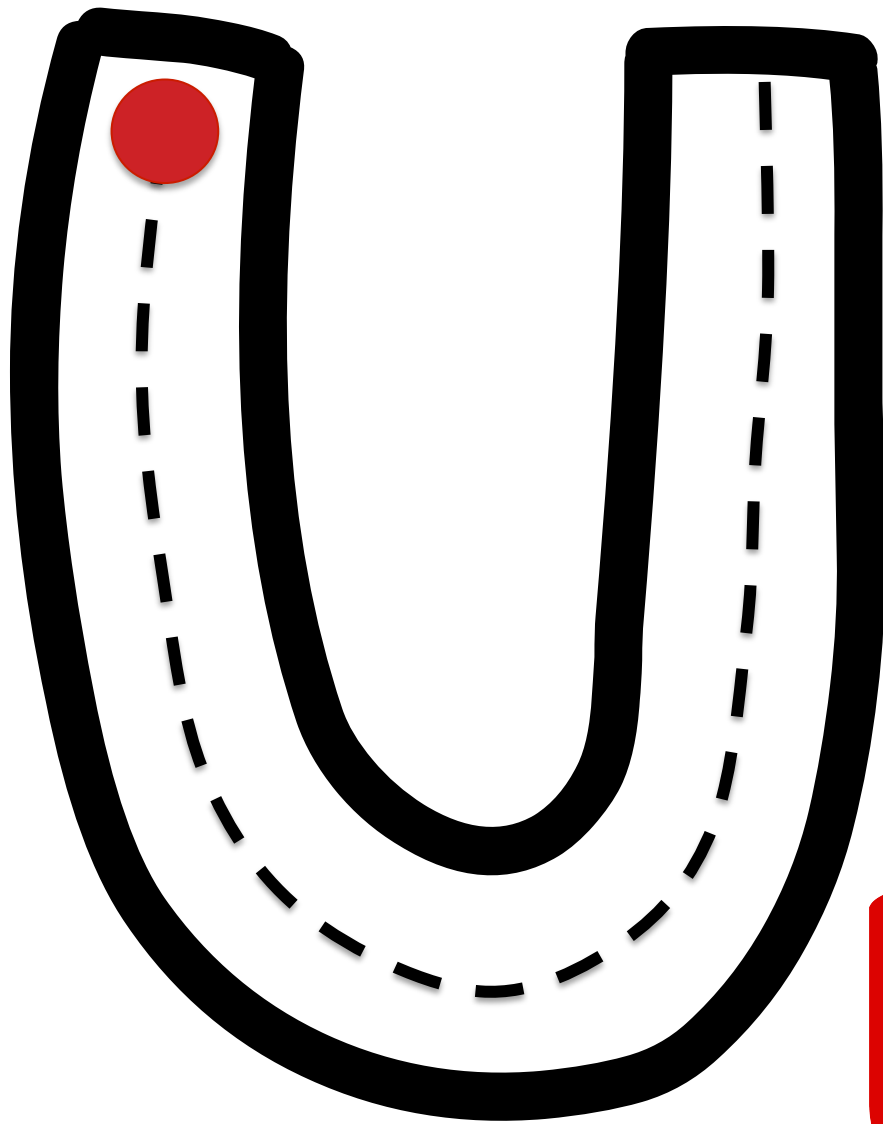
**Big I starts with
