Chant


Autumn winds begin to blow. (blow)

Scarecrow, Scarecrow


Chant

The fourth one said, "Let's waddle, waddle, waddle."


The fifth one said, "I'm ready to gobble!"



And the five melting snowmen waved a fond goodbye.




The Mitten Chant

10 Little Snowflakes


Chant

I like to play with snow! Even though its cold! It's fluffy and it's sparkly, Oh I like to play with snow!



The flowers start to bloom, The flowers start to bloom, Oh how I love the sight, The flowers start to bloom!




Five Pink Pigs

Lets plant pumpkins.


Let's plant grass seed.

Then hides in a hole – jiffity-jiff! (place hands over head to hide)





I just jump in the water and splash around!




Fishing Song

I'm at the paaaark.








The Canoe

Tune: Oh My Darling



One little, two little, three little sailboats, four little, five little, six little sailboats, seven little, eight little, nine little sailboats, ten little boats are sailing!




At the Park
