# DIRECTIONS

Before playing, make sure to print the cards and cut them apart. You may also laminate them for durability.

1. Deal 5 dominoes to each player.
2. Lay one domino in the middle.
3. Have the first player lay down a domino that matches the fraction on either side of the domino.
4. Continue to the next player and build upon the domino train.
5. If a player doesn't have a match, they draw one domino.
6. Whoever uses all their dominoes first is the winner.
