


- Print the alphabet cards. Make multiple copies if you need more than one letter.
- 2. Cut out the cards.




- 1. Find the letters you need for the child's name.

- 3. After the cards are dry, place the letters in order and glue them onto construction paper.






















## Full Names

- 2. After you've downloaded the font to your computer, open this PDF in Adobe Reader.
- 3. Type the child's name in the blue box on the next page. If your child's name is long, it may take multiple rows of letters. If the font doesn't show up, make sure to choose the font **Happy Writing Mini Circles** from the font list.
- 4. Click 'print' and it will print the personalized Q-tip names.
- 5. Have the child dip Q-tips into paint and stamp the circles.
- 6. Once the paint has dried, glue it to a piece of construction paper.
- 7. If the child's name is long and it printed on multiple rows, cut out the letters, place them in order, then glue them to the piece of construction paper.
