Prep:

1. Print the game onto card stock paper.
2. To make the spinner, poke a hole in the center of the spinner to place a brad in.
3. Place the brad in the hole. Fold the back of the brad on the backside of the paper.
4. Tape the back of the brad to backside of the paper to secure it.
5. Slip a paper clip over the brad. The paper clip is the part that you spin.
6. That's it! If you are a visual learner and need pictures, check out [this post](#).

Directions:

1. Spin the spinner.
2. Identify the lightning bug shape you landed on. (The head is the shape.)
3. Place a gem on top of the night sky shape that matches the lightning bug.
4. Keep playing until all the shapes are covered.

Notes:

This game can be played alone or in pairs. If you play in pairs, you will need two different colors of gems and whoever covers all their shapes first is the winner. You can use craft gems or something similar to cover the shapes.
